TIBETAN EXILES TO LAUNCH RETURN MARCH TO TIBET

Dharamshala - Tibetans in exile will begin a historic journey homeward to Tibet this March 10th, the 49th anniversary of the 1959 national uprising in Tibet. The March will commence from Dharamshala, the exile home of His Holiness the Dalai Lama and seat of the Tibetan Government-in-Exile. This initiative, organized by five leading Tibetan Non-governmental Organisations based in India, is aimed at both reinvigorating the Tibetan freedom movement and fighting the Chinese occupation of Tibet.
